[redacted] Mo. and [redacted] of [redacted] Mo., would like to report the animal abuse seen at Rainbow rescue on 7-23-2013 at Morse Mill Mo. We were there to view a small female mix breed dog. The owner of the rescue was not there when we arrived. We waited. The cats that were free to roam were thin. There was evidence of poor condition from the diarrhea in the rocks..all around the site. The grass was long and not mowed. When the lady arrived we introduced ourselves. She ask use to wait in the cattery building. She told us that there was a female cat having kittens the the rear of the room, so ask for us not to any further. She left to go and get the dog. The smell of rotted feces was so bad, [redacted] and left the building.. We wanted to vomit. I have had a cattery many years ago.....I have never smelled any thing so bad. She brought the little dog to a play area , so we could see the dog.. She grabbed a jug, to give the dog a drink, a couple of drops came out,,,,,the dog went flying to the bowl.....It was obvious the dog did not have water available to her in her kennel.. Her sides were gant, and hair coat not in good condition,,,possibly worms. She kept saying how the condition of the dog was good, She also sald the dog was 3 years old, but had missing teeth. I dont mind the lying, because we know how hard it is to find homes. While [redacted] was talking to her, I walked over to a kennel area near the play area, those dogs also, did not have water available. Temperatures at this time were in the90's. The border collies that I observed, weight wise looked ok. [redacted] and I are both farm managers of equestrian farms...we try when possible to adopt from Rescue facilities.
