To Whom It May Concern:

During the latest inspection of your facility, there were item(s) noted to be repeat violations of the Animal Care Facilities Act and applicable regulations. You are hereby notified that you are in violation of Missouri law and subject to penalties during your next inspection. If you do not correct these violations prior to the next consecutive inspection, you will be charge a reinspection fee of \$100.00 as specified in RSMO 273.338. If such fee goes unpaid, your license will not be renewed during the next cycle.

Repeat violations for which deadlines have expired are the following:

CATEGORY IV: Non-compliant item(s) identified this inspection:

Item No: 48 Veterinary Care

2 CSR 30-9.020 (8) Attending veterinarian and adequate veterinary care.

5/19/2014 - An uncontained gray cat identified as "Boozer" by the licensee was noted by Dr. Cook to have bilateral mucopurulent ocular discharge, dull hair coat, and thin body condition. Licensee stated that the cat was part of the rescue. Licensee indicated that the cat was geriatric. Licensee did not have any documentation available regarding veterinary care at the time of the inspection. Licensee shall have the cat examined by a veterinarian. Licensee shall maintain documentation of the examination and any executed treatments for review upon future inspection.

9/23/2014 - Licensee stated that Boozer had been examined by Dr. Legg. However, licensee was unable to produce documentation of any examination or treatments. This item has not been corrected.
